

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANITOUWADGE

BY-LAW NO. 2003-07


Being a By-law to give the Public Works Superintendent authority to temporarily close roads.

WHEREAS Section 42 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides a municipality may delegate to an employee of the municipality, subject to any conditions which the municipality may impose, the power to close a highway temporarily for any purpose specified in the by-law.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Manitouwadge enacts as follows:

1. That the Public Works Superintendent of the Corporation of the Township of Manitouwadge is hereby granted the authority to close any road, street or lane within the Township of Manitouwadge because of:
 - (a) hazardous road conditions,
 - (b) construction requirements,
 - (c) maintenance or repair requirements,
 - (d) any other condition that, in the opinion of the Public Works Superintendent, requires temporary closure to ensure the safety of the general public.
2. That any such closure may be invoked at the discretion of the Public Works Superintendent without prior approval from the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Manitouwadge.
3. That, where possible, advance public notice of the closure shall be given.
4. That the closure of any road, street or lane for reasons other than those set out above must receive the prior approval of the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Manitouwadge.
5. That this by-law shall come into force upon adoption by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Manitouwadge.
