

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANITOUWADGE

BY-LAW NO. 95- 47

Being a By-law to adopt a policy respecting financial or other assistance

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. M.45 as amended provides that the Council may pass by-laws for the health, safety, morality and welfare of the inhabitants in matters not specifically provided for by this Act;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation receives many requests for financial assistance from individuals, groups, organizations and for worthy causes;

AND WHEREAS it is the Council's philosophy that it should not be taxpayers' dollars that should be the source of any financial assistance but rather left to the discretion of the individual;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Manitowadge enacts as follows that:

1. DEFINITIONS - In this by-law;

- (1) "Chief Administrative Officer" shall mean the Chief Administrative Officer of the Corporation.
- (2) "Corporation" shall mean the Corporation of the Township of Manitowadge.
- (3) "Council" shall mean the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Manitowadge.
- (4) "Municipality" shall mean the Corporation of the Township of Manitowadge.
- (5) "Petitioner" shall mean a group, organization, individual or cause requesting financial assistance.

2. The Corporation shall provide no direct financial assistance to any petitioner.

3. All requests for financial assistance shall be reviewed by the Chief Administrative Officer who shall have the full authority to take whatever action he or she deems necessary.

4. The Chief Administrative Officer may recommend that a special fund-raising event or events be facilitated by either the Council or the Council along with the Petitioner. All of the net proceeds of the special fund-raising event or events shall be forwarded to the Petitioner for which the event was or the events were held.


5. Where any by-law passed prior to this by-law conflicts with this by-law, the terms of this by-law shall prevail.


6. If there is a conflict between this by-law and the Municipal Act, the provisions of the Municipal Act shall prevail.

7. This by-law may be known as the "Financial Assistance By-Law".

8. this By-law comes into force and takes effect upon the date of its passing.
