

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANITOUWADGE

BY-LAW NO. 2003-15

Being a By-law respecting signing authority

WHEREAS Section 288 (1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25*, provides that every cheque issued by a municipality shall be signed by the treasurer and the head of council.

AND WHEREAS Section 288 (2) of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25*, provides that a municipality may designate persons to sign cheques in place of the treasurer or the head of council but the same person cannot be designated to sign in place of both of them.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Manitouwadge enacts as follows that:

1. The Mayor, together with the Treasurer shall have authority to sign cheques drawn on any of the Corporation's bank accounts.
2. In the absence of the Treasurer, the Clerk or Deputy-Clerk are hereby authorized to sign cheques drawn on any of the Corporation's bank accounts and
3. In the absence of the Mayor, that any other members of Council are hereby authorized to sign cheques drawn on any of the Corporation's bank accounts.
4. this By-law comes into force and takes effect upon the date of its passing.
