Please place your material for pick-up beside the roadway
By Monday morning, May 29th.

Putting waste on the roadway the weekend before:
(on May 27th & 28th is acceptable)

*PLEASE NOTE THAT EACH STREET WILL BE COMPLETED
ONLY ONCE DURING SPRING CLEAN-UP WEEK.*

- ❖ **Clean your yards and ditches of winter remnants, sand, tree branches, and dead grass;**
- ❖ **Beautify around your home and contribute to a clean community.**

Please leave all materials raked or swept from lawns in
NEAT piles beside the roadway
Arrange separate piles for scrap metal and wood.

Waste from the Building Demolition and large renovation projects are outside of the scope of clean-up week.

To arrange for pick ups of old car bodies or bulky white metal appliances, please call the Public Works Department at 826-3227, ext. 230.

For removal of appliances with Freon, you must contact the Public Works Dept. as a fee of \$66.00 must be paid to provide the removal of Freon in an environmentally safe manner.

The Township of Manitouwadge will be waiving the landfill site tipping fees for Cars, Half Ton Pick-Up Trucks, Utility Trailers, and Tandem Dump Trailers for the days of May 27th, 29th, 31st, & June 3rd, 2017 to further support Clean-up Week 2017

The **Household Hazardous** Waste Collection **will not** be held in conjunction with our Spring Clean-Up Week
Save all your hazardous waste as our collection will be held on **Saturday, October 14th.**

The Public Works Department will have the final say as to what will be picked up and if you are not sure what gets picked up, Please call the Township to inquire in regards to specific items before placing beside the roadway.
